(Cañavate, 1948) Francisco Luzón López earned his degree in Economics and Business from the University of the Basque Country. He has also been President of Argentaria and member of the Board of Directors of BBVA since 1986. Between 1988 and 1996, he was President of the Foreign Office of the Bank of Spain.

He worked with Santander Bank, S.A. in the areas of strategy, communication and international relations. He was later chosen as the manager of the bank in Latin America where he served until 2012.

He teaches at the University of Deusto and is the External Director of Inditex, the World Vice President of Universia, and second Vice President of Universia Royal Trust for the National Library. In September 2012 he was appointed director of LATAM Airlines Group, S.A.
