José Lladó Fernández-Urrutia earned a Ph.D. in Chemistry from the University of Madrid. He was Minister of Commerce and Minister of Transport and Communications in the first governments of the Spanish democracy. Subsequently, he was Ambassador of Spain in Washington D.C. He was the first President of the Board of Trustees of the National Museum Centro de Arte Reina Sofia (1986-1994).

He is President and founder of Technical Reunidas S.A., and Director of the following companies: Company Sevillana of Electricity, Acerinox, and Energy & Industries Aragonese. He is also Honorary Member of the American Institute of Chemists, President of Xavier Zubiri Foundation, President of the Prince of Asturias Award for the Arts (1992-2001), Founding Trustee and Vice President of the Free University Emeritus College, Trustee of the Foundation of Prince Asturias, and International Director of the Center for Strategic & International Studies in Washington, D.C. Since November 1996, he has been Chairman of the Board of the Foundation, INCIPE.
